EXHIBITOR OR LEGAL GAURDIAN***

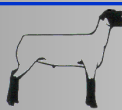




