





Beginning September 1, 2024, all enrolled Kerr 4-H youth will be required to EITHER attend 50% of their club monthly meetings or complete and submit a project record book, to pick up their Kerr County Livestock Show Sale check. This is in addition to writing a thank you card to each of the listed buyers. If the youth elects to complete the record book (click here for record book document), they will follow the instructions for their age division (Junior 1st - 5th, Intermediate 6th - 8th, and Senior 9th - 12th). 

- 4. Three-placing limit on top awards by contest leaderboard.
- 5. Tournaments will provide for **8 weeks of fishing** during spring and summer.
- 6. 4-H youth have the opportunity to earn their **Texas 4-H Sportfishing project certification and pin.**
- 7. A belt buckle to be awarded Spring AND Summer Freshwater and Saltwater Grand Slam Champions
